## How to get to Florence:

Florence can be easily reached by:

- *Train*: Rapid trains (frecciarossa) are available from the main Italian cities and night-trains from the main European capitals. The central station is Firenze Santa Maria Novella
- *Airplane*
  - Aeroporto di Firenze (Amerigo Vespucci / Peretola airport) is inside Florence and very close to city center (25 minutes of bus),
  - Aeroporto di Pisa (Galileo Galilei airport) is in Pisa (one hour of bus/train from Florence) and different low cost companies (Ryanair, Easyjet) fly there,
  - Aeroporto di Bologna (35 minutes of rapid train).

## Registration
